Trial Eligibility

- **You must be a Member of TDAA. Membership forms and information is available at www.k9tdaa.com.**
- Your dog must be registered with TDAA to compete in TDAA trials. Dog Registration forms and information is available at www.k9tdaa.com. **If you have sent a registration form for your dog to TDAA but their number has not been received, please mark PENDING in the TDAA number space on the entry form.** • This trial is open to all dogs, without regard to breed or pedigree, measuring 20" or less, who are at least 12 months of age. No dog may participate with apparent injuries, lameness, or bandages. Blind dogs, bitches in season, and dogs that are aggressive may not compete.
- Dogs with three legs or feet, either by amputation or birth defect, shall be able to compete so long as the disability doesn't clearly create a safety hazard for the dog.
- A dog must be entered under the name of the current owner. TDAA Transfer applications for ownership are available.
- Dogs must be up to date on vaccinations and/or titers.

Day of Trial and Late Entries

If you have sent a **pre-entry**, and during the trial wish to add additional runs, you will not be charged the additional day of-trial entry fee for those runs since your information was previously recorded for this trial. **To make any changes to your entry on any run, you must provide that change to the trial secretary at least 1 class prior to the running of the class you want to change.**

JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL SUPERSEDES THESE PRINTED BRIEFINGS.

Touch and go - is a numbered course consisting of tunnels and contact obstacles only! ER12

Quidditch - is a simple game of handling skill. The handler must direct the dog to perform three sequences of escalating value and attempting the simple performance of a specified tunnel after each. The game is full of interesting bonuses and colorful phraseology. ER2

Slither - is a points game consisting of jumps and tunnels taken either in a serpentine or threadle fashion by handler/dog choice with distance option for higher points. ER2

Standard Course BETA "Walk Once, Run Twice"

Beta format is for pairs of Standard runs (1 & 2, 3 & 4, and so on) and allows you to run the same course twice in the same course order (no renumbering of obstacles, no changing the course). There is no 2nd walk-thru before round 2, so if you're only running round 2, you walk before round 1.

FEO (For Exhibition Only)

What is FEO?? FEO is the opportunity to run your dog in a trial setting while not officially competing. For dogs not quite ready for trialing, this is a chance to practice a competition course under trial conditions. And if your dog didn't do well on a particular course during a scored run, this is a chance to try the course again. FEO runs are not eligible for placements (or for qualifying), although they will be judged and scored (compared to a fun run, which is not sanctioned, judged, or recorded.)

Class Information

STANDARD AGILITY

Beginner	All dogs in sound physical condition, meeting the height specifications of the organization, and familiar with all obstacles shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Intermediate	Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Superior	Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES

Games I	All dogs in sound physical condition, meeting the height specifications of the organization, and familiar with all obstacles shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games II	Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games III	Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Move-Ups

Move ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show with written notice to the trial secretary, emails are accepted. Dayof-trial move ups will also be accepted, except as noted below between Standard Beta runs.

Height Divisions

The TDAA offers the following Measured Jump Height Divisions: 4", 8", 12", 16"; and the following Jump Heights: 2", 4", 8", 12", 16". Owners/handlers are responsible for entering their dog at the proper height division, both the dog's Measured Jump Height and the height at which they want their dog to jump at the trial. **Per TDAA rules, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's Measured Jump Height.** Dogs jumping at a height other than their Measured Jump Height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Any dog that has not previously competed at a TDAA trial must be measured before competing.

Time Accommodations for Veteran Dogs & Disabled Handlers

Veteran Dogs: Veteran dogs receive additional time in Standard runs based on their measured height division. Double-digit veteran dogs receive an additional extension in standard course time. Additional time in games will depend on scoring criteria. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs.

Disabled Handlers: Disabled handlers receive an additional 4 seconds for Standard runs. Additional time in games will depend on scoring criteria. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial. There is no special system of titling for disabled handlers.

Mulligan

A "mulligan," is a situation where the handler is given the opportunity to re-run an event with the second run superseding the first. No more than one mulligan per dog, per day will be allowed.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Titling ribbons will also be awarded to dogs completing a title. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the TDAA Rules and Regulations. The following is a list of obstacles to be used. Contacts have rubber coating. This trial will be held indoors on 3/4-inch (EVA Foam) Agility Matting

A-frame (6'8" x 30" wide)	Tire Jump (15")	Dog walk (12' ramps)	Table (36" by 36")
Open [Pipe] Tunnel (24")	Single & winged jumps (36")	Teeter (8' x 12" wide)	Weave poles (22" centers)

A Warmup jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Obstacle familiarization is available each morning prior to judging.

DIRECTIONS to the Trial -- -- Gemini Dogs

DIRECTIONS: Take Interstate 495 to Route 2A/110 exit. Turn left and travel just over a mile on Route 2A/110 West. Go through a stoplight located at the gas station. As you crest the hill, you will notice a gravel company on your right. Please note that GPS devices cannot find our main door. They can get you to this point on Route 2A/110, however. Watch for the gravel company, and then turn right onto Distribution Center Drive. If you immediately look to your right, you will see the trial site; we are located in a very large concrete warehouse. Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- All entries must be submitted on an Official TDAA Agility Entry Form with the signed TDAA agreement. One entry form per dog. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable. A \$25.00 service charge will be charged for any returned checks. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. All fees must be paid in US funds
- Bitches in season and injured dogs are not permitted in the trial. A refund will be given for withdrawals up to and including the day of the trial. A letter from your veterinarian may be required.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance, repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All participants in TDAA events, including competitors, judges, regional master judges, trial chairs, secretaries, members, vendors, handlers, owners of dogs, and anyone else involved with a TDAA event must refrain from behavior detrimental to the confidence, or the public perception, of the TDAA's events and integrity.
- Those involved in the TDAA's events must behave in ways that do not negatively reflect on dog agility and the TDAA.
- Conduct by anyone that is reckless, careless, perilous, turbulent, violent, or illegal puts others at risk, damages the reputation of others in the TDAA organization, and undercuts public respect and support for the TDAA is to be avoided.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar, with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties, or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s).
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- Food and toys are permitted in the course area in accordance with TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices at the Trial Site. • This trial shall be judged under the current Rules and Regulations of the TDAA. Rules can be obtained online at www.k9tdaa.com.
